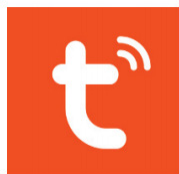

Quick Start for Wi-Fi Plug Setup

NOTE: Different mobile operating systems may have some small variations in the setup process shown below.

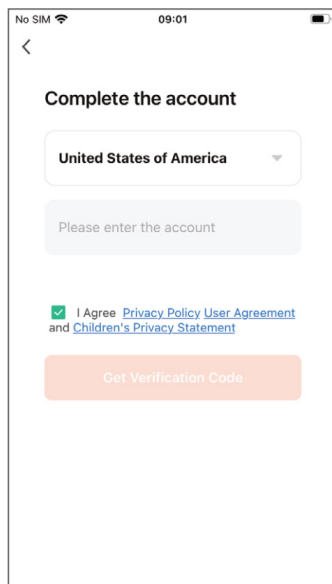


1. Download Tuya Smart app from the App Store or Google Play.

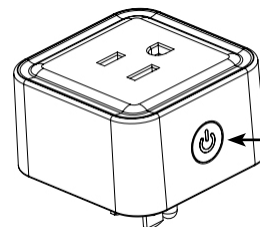


2. Connect mobile device to your 2.4GHz Wi-Fi network. Please note this smart plug can only be connected via a 2.4GHz network.

3. Launch the Tuya Smart app.



4. Install the Smart Wi-Fi Plug and make it into Paring Mode.



Wi-Fi Outlet Control Button with Indicator light

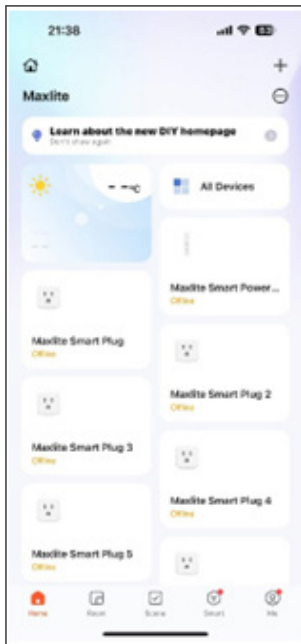
b.) Plug the Smart Plug into a grounded indoor outlet. Turn on the Power ON/OFF Switch, and short press the Wi-Fi Outlets Control, then the Wi-Fi Status Indicator Light will be off and then short press again after off for 10 seconds, and this indicator light on again, then pressing this Wi-Fi Outlet Control Button for 5 seconds. You will hear a sound of "Dida", and the Wi-Fi Status Indicator Lights start flickering, which means the smart Wi-Fi plug has gone into paring mode.

If it is not flickering, then restart over again to get into parting mode.

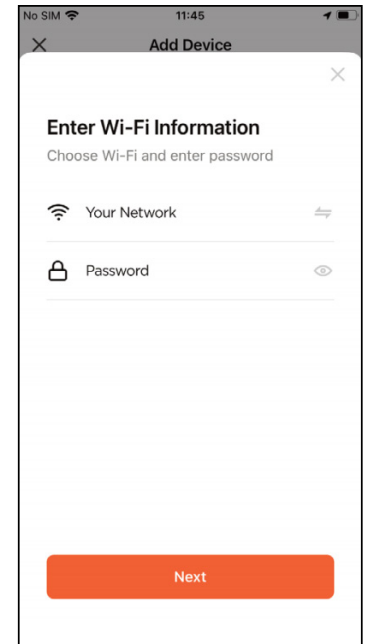
c.) Open Tuya App and press “+” to start adding the device.



d.) Then you will see the image of “MaxLite Smart Plug” and press the image to continue.

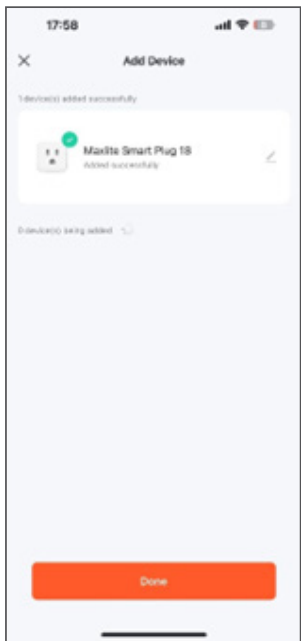


e.) If you do not see the image of “MaxLite Smart Plug”, then press “Plug (BLE+Wi-Fi)” to continue.

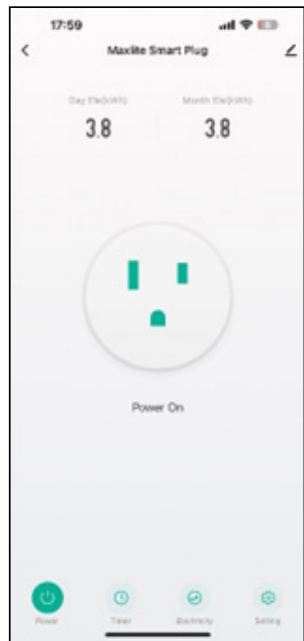


f.) Input Wi-Fi and Password and press “Next” to complete.

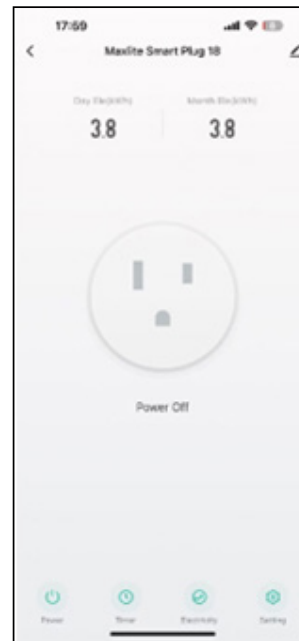
Manual Setup for Wi-Fi Plug



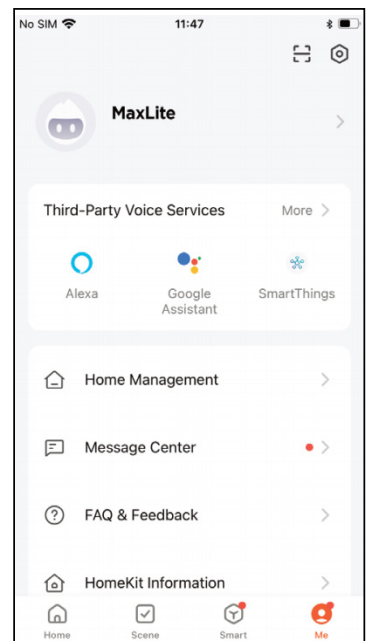
g.) Wait until you see the “Added successfully” message and press “Done”.
